The Children of Latinia is a performance project that looks at the realities of hybrid Americans that consider themselves “Latinos”. Children born in the US with at least one Latino parent: Ethiopian – Guatemalans, Palestinian – Salvadoreans, Mexican – Iranians, Japanese – Colombians, etc... As the United States starts to become “a brown nation” Quique Aviles delves into a new reality of a new generation. This time as an outsider, Aviles, the immigrant, looking at hybrid Latinos that are the new voice and the new face of a changing America. The project has involved numerous interviews and conversations, reading and research that culminates in a series of 12 performances and 4 scholarly led post-performance discussions.
