On May 21st, 1961, former Adolf Eichmann is captured by Israeli Agents in Argentina. Nine days after he is taken to Israel and detained in a secret prison where Captain Avner Less interrogates him in preparation for his trial. Eichmann minimizes his participation in the mass murder of millions as Captain Less tries to expose the role played by this "ordinary" SS Colonel who made the trains run on time to the death camps of the Third Reich. Inspired by the transcripts from the Israeli Police archives this drama explores the brutal machinations of the Final Solution's implementation.
