Taylor Johnson is a poet from Washington, DC. They have received fellowships and scholarships from Cave Canem, Callaloo, Lambda Literary Foundation, VONA, the Vermont Studio Center, and the Fine Arts Work Center in Provincetown, MA. Recently, their work appears in the *minnesota review* and *Callaloo*.



Jee Leong Koh's most recent book of poems *Steep Tea* (Carcanet) was named a Best Book of 2015 by UK's *Financial Times*, and a Finalist by *Lambda Literary*. He is the author of three other books of poems and a book of *zuihitsu*. His work has been shortlisted for the *Singapore Literature Prize* and translated into Japanese, Chinese, Russian, and Latvian. Originally from Singapore, Jee lives in New York City, where he edits the arts magazine *Singapore Poetry* and runs the *Singapore Literature Festival* in NYC.
